



The Court finds that if a child is committed to a detention facility pursuant to Juvenile Rule 7, the Court may order either one or both parents/guardians to pay the sum of Seventy-Five dollars (\$75.00) per diem as child support for the child's care and maintenance during the course of the child's detention. If the Court finds that the parent/guardian or parents/guardians are indigent, the Court shall suspend the payment of such support. Indigency is to be determined by using the Guidelines for Appointed Counsel Reimbursement established by the Office of the Ohio Public Defender.
